

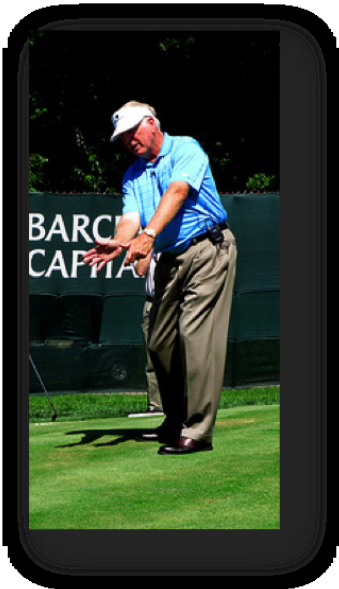
**Lynn Blake** embraced his passion for teaching golf and began a second career in January 2004. Since that time, the results have been truly startling:
